During the webinar (the main recording is now available on our <u>webinar page</u>) Laura and I talked about one of the things event managers dread - the onstage sales pitch. Soon afterward.



in a conversation with another speaker (a very successful speaker), I heard these words, "I would never give a sales pitch on stage."

Yes, there is a time and a place for a sales pitch but onstage at conferences and events, usually isn't it.

Demonstrate your expertise. Change minds. Show people how to look at the world differently. But showing up with an overt sales pitch and you lose all credibility, especially with senior executives. When you are presenting, you are kicking off a new relationship. Trying to sell something immediately is like asking someone to marry you on the first date.

OK, no selling, but what can you do?

- Help your audience identify a problem
- Inspire them to seek a solution
- Educate them about options
- Show them a different path
